Charles "Charlie" Albert Hall was born to the late John Henry and Ruth Mae Crier Hall on February 6, 1944 in Independence, LA. He received his education in St. Helena Parish where he graduated High School in 1961.

Charles moved to New Orleans, LA in his early 20's where he met and married Lillie Mae Howard Hall (deceased, 2006). To this union, five children were born: Mark Albert, Gwendolyn Ann, Thomas Edward, David Wayne, and Bryant Charles Hall. He was also the father of Tanya and Corey Walker.
