Hayward Andrews Jr. went home to be with the Lord on January 25, 2024 in Baton Rouge at the age of 75. He was a beloved husband, father and grandfather who will be deeply missed by all who knew him.

Hayward Jr. was born to the late Hayward and Dorothy Andrews Sr. on February 6, 1948 in Baton Rouge, Louisiana where he spent his formative years. At an early age, he accepted Christ as his personal Lord and Savior at the Mt. Pilgram Baptist Church under the Pastoral leadership of his father Rev. Hayward Andrews Sr.

He received his education in the East Baton Rouge Parish School System. He graduated from Capitol High School in 1966. Upon completion of high school, Hayward Jr. enrolled and completed two years of education at Southern

University A&M College. From there, he enlisted in the United States Army in November 1968 where he served his country until he was honorably discharged in March 1970.

In 1970 he moved his membership to Oak Ridge Missionary Baptist Church also under the leadership of his father, Rev. Hayward Andrews Sr. where he served many roles over the years to include: Local 3rd District Brotherhood President, Gospel Chorus President, Assistant Sunday School Teacher (class #6), Assistant and Chairman of the Deacon Ministry and Minister of Music. It was also in 1970 when married the love of his life, Emma (Garner) Andrews (53 years). To their union four children were born.

He was a dedicated employee of The Baton Rouge Water Company from 1970 until his earthly departure where he served many roles to include: Construction Worker, Off and On Connection Officer, Leak Detection Forman, Survey Officer and Sample Transporter. In this personal time found his passion in Lawn Care Services and taking family vacations. He was known for joking about "not truly being on vacation until you get lost."
